

Subject – New Aged Care Act Exposure Draft

The proposed “New Aged Care Act” neglects to include an “Overarching introductory statement” regarding the provider ensuring “Normalcy, Humility and Respect” on their Residential Care Sites.

The atmosphere shall not be one of warehousing occupants, but creating

- A small village atmosphere (of up to 16 in a cottage/group homes)
- Preferably at ground level for ease of independent movement
- Ensure no sensory deprivation (i.e. easily see the horizon, day and night differences, colour of sky, landscaping, birds and butterflies, etc.
- Foster and encourage independence for as long as possible and practical.Care
- Etc.
