Contribution amounts for residential care are unfair and not equitable. For those who have worked hard, contributing to the Australian community paying taxes and living within their means and saving for their ageing are going to be unfairly billed. Many people spend through their lives and donâ€<sup>™</sup>t save and they will pay far less due to less savings. People are encouraged to downsize and this can result in savings and again results in to paying more.

These costing changes will result in many not considering residential care but accessing on home services or going without care so there is no expense. Malnutrition, social isolation will occur. Children wanting to inherit will keep aging parents at home in some cases neglect and elder abuse will occur with case numbers escalating. I will not vote for a government that is unable to consider the inequity that is being proposed for those who have worked hard to have savings. I for one will certainly commence spending of funds to reduce my savings so that ultimately i will need to be provided with an age pension so adding to Governments costs. The currently funding model enables families to have a decent return to them at the death of parent.
