

I have read the documents. Home modifications section rules . I found it difficult to understand . I also found the section on assistive technology unclear - does it only apply to rural residents ? Re: CHSP . The rules regarding the co payment assessment for clients ( per hour ) is unclear . General observation: providers of both CHSP and HCP must be regularly able to prove that they have sufficient trained staff to provide for their on books client needs. In addition , providers must not pass on to the client - the workers travel to the client costs - be it by deducting it from on site ( in clients home ) work time or adding on costs . Rates of remuneration paid to workers must be clearly defined ( tax, super, insurance, agency fees) before actual end pay to worker declared . Thanks .
