

Privacy notice

The Australian Government Department of Health and Aged Care (the **Department**) invites you to share your views on the review into the *Australian Sports Commission Act 1989* (Cth).

Your personal information is protected by law, including the *Privacy Act 1988* (**Privacy Act**) and the Australian Privacy Principles, and is being collected by the department for the purposes of conducting a consultation process in relation to the review of the *Australian Sports Commission Act 1989* (Cth). The Department will collect your personal information at the time that you provide a submission, unless you choose to make a submission anonymously, and you are not reasonably identifiable from the information provided in your submission.

Please **do not** include in the body of your submission any information which identifies another individual, or any information from which another individual is reasonably identifiable.

How consultation data will be collected, stored and managed

- that any information provided may be shared between Professor McMillan, Clayton Utz and the Department
- that any information provided may be subject to requests under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (Cth)
- that respondents' contributions may be used to inform the development of a report on the review of the Act, which may be published, and
- submissions may be published, as described further below.

Your information will be stored securely and used in accordance with the Department's Privacy Policy.

After reading this notice, you will be given the option to consent to, or not consent to, the publication of your submission on the Department's website. If you consent to publication of your submission, you will be given the option of whether you consent to your name and/or your organisation's name being published with the submission.

Publication of your submission

If after reading this notice, you consent to the publication of your submission including your name and/or the name of your organisation, the department may, at its discretion, publish part or all of your submission on the department's website. If your submission is published, the department may identify you and/or your organisation as the author of the submission.
