



Privacy Notice – National Health and Climate Strategy Consultation

Your personal information is protected by law, including the Privacy Act 1988 (Privacy Act) and the Australian Privacy Principles, and is being collected by the Department, via Citizen Space, for the purposes of conducting a consultation process in relation to the National Health and Climate Strategy. The Department will collect your personal information at the time that you provide a submission.

Sensitive information is personal information that includes information or an opinion about an individual's:

- racial or ethnic origin
- political opinions or associations
- religious or philosophical beliefs
- trade union membership or associations
- sexual orientation or practices
- criminal record
- health or genetic information
- some aspects of biometric information.

Although the Department is not routinely requesting sensitive information through this consultation, the Department understands that some of the matters discussed in submissions may include details of a sensitive nature. By making a submission containing your sensitive information, you consent to the Department collecting that information.

We will disclose your information to:

- the entity engaged to undertake analysis of the submissions, KPMG
- anyone you've agreed we can share it with
- anyone the law requires or authorises us to share it with.

Personal information that you provide will only be used for the purpose of this consultation and your submission will not be made public. However, parts of your submission may be incorporated into the final Strategy in aggregate anonymised form or in the form of anonymised quotes. If the Department would like to use a quote directly from your submission, the Department will approach you directly to obtain your consent.
