On aged pensions, My loved ones cannot afford to contribute to these services, and if we cant afford the 17.5% to have the services provided;

Where and how do I, as a (dual) Carer, fit in mowing lawns clippings hedges, cleaning the house, and bathrooms after two elderly disabled men?

In my case I fear for my own health as $l\hat{a} \in \mathbb{I}$ be heading for a breakdown trying to do everything if there is limited funding for these things.

Not to mention the potential risk to the health and safety of my loved ones if I am too exhausted to complete the tasks needed to keep them safe.

Please help to change these rules before it's too late for us all
