Restrictive practices, choice and decision making and dignity of risk interplay.

In release 3, regarding Chemical restrictive practice, Division 2, 162-25 Additional requirements for the use of restrictive practices that are chemical restraints, (1)(b)(vii) the details of the prescription for the prescribed medication, including its name, dosage and when it may be used; - to enter this onto the Behaviour Support Plan is transcribing for Registered Nurses and is outside the scope of the Registered Nurse as they are noting the name, dosage and indication for use of a medication, and this sits within a prescribers delegation. Therefore, the source of truth for this information is the medication chart and should not be transcribed to the Behaviour Support Plan. GPs will not complete a BSP.
