To realise a single, secure, and easy to use place where industry can interact with government to apply, track, pay, and manage listing for regulated and reimbursed health-related products and services.


PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The objective of the Program is to establish a single-entry point for industry to interact with the Department and enable consistent, simplified business processes to support regulated and reimbursed health-related products and services.

This will be achieved through a digital solution that supports legislative compliance and evidence-based decision making and reimbursed business transparency. It includes the design, build, change and deploy of a new enterprise capability for the Department, supporting over \$46 billion dollars of healthcare expenditure. The Program will deliver improvements in **7 core functions** associated with the management of regulated and reimbursed health-related products/services.


PROGRAM FOCUS

-  **Prostheses List (PL)** via the independent advisory *Prostheses List Advisory Committee* (PLAC)
-  **Medicare Benefits Schedule (MBS)** via the independent advisory *Medical Services Advisory Committee* (MSAC)
-  **Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS)** via the associated independent advisory *Pharmaceutical Benefits Advisory Committee* (PBAC)




Double diamond framework
